The Assam Public Service Commission is pleased to declare the results of the Combined Competitive (Main) Exam., 2014 on today the 18th May, 2016. A total of **1536** candidates appeared in the said examination out of **2048** candidates.

Based on the said results of the C.C. Exam., 2014, a total of **371** candidates are declared to have qualified to appear the viva-voce interview against **180** posts of ACS and Allied Services at the ratio of **1:2** plus the number of candidates who secured equal marks at the bottom line of each category with due regards to the prescribed reservations as per the terms of the advertisement. Out of the **371** candidates called for viva-voce, **126** candidates belong to women category and **8** candidates belong to Persons with Disabilities (PWD).

The Commission has decided to hold the viva-voce interview tentatively *w.e.f.* 15.06.2016 onwards.
