Consequent to the decision of the Government of India and the State of Assam, the APSC observed the 'Constitution Day' today, the 26th November, 2018 in a solemn function held in its office premises in presence of Hon'ble Chairman, Hon'ble Members, Officers and staff of the Commission.

At the beginning, Prakash Ranjan Gharphalia, ACS, Secretary to the Commission explained the purpose of the function. Thereafter, Shri Dipak Kr Sarma, IAS (Retd.), Hon'ble Chairman (i/c) read out the 'Preamble' to the Constitution followed by a speech to the gathering. In his speech, the Hon'ble Chairman elaborated the significance of the Day. He said that it was on this day in 1949, the Constitution of India was adopted, by the Constituent Assembly. The Constitution is the basis of the pillars of administration – the Legislative, the Judiciary and the Executive. The 'Preamble' highlights the character of our republic. He stressed the need of gathering working knowledge about the relevant articles, schedules etc. of the Constitution so as to help the Government employees particularly the staff of the Commission, being a Constitutional body.

He also pointed out that celebration of the Day will help the citizens of India to spread the thoughts and ideology of Dr Ambekar and the Members of the committee. The function also paid deep respect to the architects of the Constitution who toiled hard to frame the biggest Constitution of the world.

The meeting was attended by Shri Mukti Gogoi, IAS (Retd.), Shri P.K. Hazoari, ACS (Retd.), Hon'ble Members, Mrs Pubali Gohain, ACS, Principal Controller of Examinations of the Commission and all the staff of the Commission.
