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INTRODUCTION

CHAPTER - 1

INTRODUCTION

Brief History and composition of the Commission:

- 1.1. The Assam Public Service Commission (APSC) came into being on the 1st day of April, 1937 in accordance with the provisions of the Govt. of India Act, 1935. Mr. James Hazellet, a retired ICS Officer was the first to be appointed as Chairman of the Commission. On India becoming a Republic at the commencement of the Constitution of India, the Assam Public Service Commission Regulations were framed by the Governor of Assam in 1951 in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 318 of the Constitution of India. These Regulations came into force with effect from the 1st day of Sept, 1951.
- 1.2. The Assam Public Service Commission Regulations, 1951 have, since their Commencement, undergone a few amendments in respect of composition of the Commission and by an amendment of 2005, the strength of the Commission was fixed at 7(seven) consisting of a Chairman and 6(six) Members.
- 1.3. Accordingly, the sanctioned strength of the Commission at present consists of one Chairman and 6(six) Members which also include a Woman Member. Against the sanctioned strength, the composition of the Commission during the period under report is as stated below.

CHAPTER - 2

SECRETARIAT OF THE COMMISSION AND ITS FUNCTIONS

Secretary

The head of the Office of the Commission is the Secretary. He exercises general supervision and control over the staff of the Commission and is responsible for ensuring staff officials carry out their allotted works efficiently and expeditiously. It is his duty to take effective steps for prompt dispatch of business in the office. In addition of these the Secretary has superintending control over the entire office including administrative control of the office building. He also convenes and attends the meetings of the Commission and such other functions as assigned by the Commission. The Secretary is in general charge of all offices of the Commission.

The Secretariat of the Commission is located in its own building at Jawaharnagar, Khanapara, Guwahati-22, comprising multistoried building with 3 Blocks having two examination halls.

FUNCTION:

The Assam Public Service Commission has to discharge the duties and functions specified in Article 320 of the Constitution. The Commission apart from conducting examinations for appointments to the services of the state, is required to advice Government on all matters relating to framing of Recruitment Rules, Principle to be followed in making appointments, promotions and in respect of disciplinary matters affecting Civil Servants. Hence it is required to consult the Commission in the matters of recruitment, promotions, disciplinary matters, framing of recruitment rules and other service matters of the Assam State Services (Namely ACS, APS, AFS, AESS, Ranger Course in Forestry, BDO etc.). One of the major functions of the Commission is to conduct its Combined Competitive Examination which is regarded as the most prestigious examination, for selection to Assam Civil Services & other allied categories. The Commission could also be consulted in respect of appointment to certain categories of posts on local authority, statutory corporation, or a public institution under the provisions of Article 321 of the Constitution.

**** Results of the interview were not declared during the year under report. Number of candidates recommended during the year depends upon the vacancies intimated for those selections whose results are declared during the year.

CHAPTER - 4

FINANCIAL MATTERS:

1.6 The Commission was in receipt of Rs. 33,57,070 (Rupees Thirty Three Lakhs Fifty Seven Thousand and Seventy) only during the year under report.

The receipt was mostly from various application fees, RTI fees and Examinations fees etc. collected in connection with the various posts advertised.

The annual budget for the year was Rs. 11,84,43,000.00 (Rupees Eleven Crores Eighty Four Lakhs Forty Three thousand only). The expenditure of the Commission was Rs. 10,23,60,788.00 (Rupees Ten Crores Twenty Three Lakhs Sixty Thousand and Seven Hundred Eighty Eight) only. Detail information relating to financial receipts and expenditure during the year 2015-2016 is shown in Appendix-II. All the financial matters are dealt with in the Accounts Branch of the commission. They include salary, allowances and pension payable to Chairman, Members and the staff of the Commission and other expenses that come under different head of account. The Account branch also prepares the budget estimates of the Commission for each financial year.

CHAPTER - 5

OTHER MATTERS RELATING TO THE COMMISSION:

DELAYED OFFER OF APPOINTMENT:

1.19 It comes to Commission's notice that the offer of appointment to candidates recommended by the Commission on the basis of Written Examination/Direct Recruitment by the interview and in case of promotions were delayed in several cases by the concerned departments during the year under report. (Details in Appendix-IV).

EXAMINATION WINGS:

1.20 The Commission is continuously engaged in pre-interview programmes for various posts and also reviewing the examination and interview methodology and other allied matters. The Commission has introduced objective type tests in many of their Examination for which "Question Item Bank" in various discipline is maintained confidentially for utilization, in case any such need arises.

INSTALLATION OF THE INTELLIGENT CHARACTER RECOGNITION (ICR) BASED EXAMINATION AUTOMATION SYSTEM:

1.21 The Intelligent Character Recognition (ICR) based Examination Automation System of the Commission was inaugurated by Sri Tarun Gogoi, the then Hon'ble Chief Minister of Assam on 24th Feb. 2011.

This system automates every step of existing examination process right from processing of application to preparation of result sheet and places checks in every step to eliminate common errors.

The system has the intelligence of verification and validation of each record with less human intervention, making it an error free unbiased process. Also the time taken by the system is much lesser than the manual processing.

1.22 The installation of the above system based on advanced technology would go a long way to further the cause of maintaining high degree of transparency and professional efficiency of the Commission.

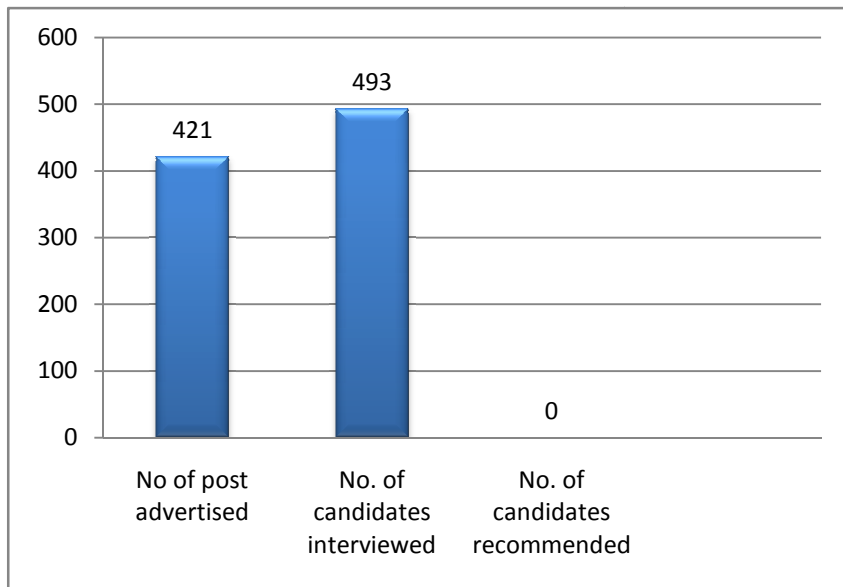
1.23 INTRODUCTION OF ONLINE SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION: Assam Public Service Commission introduced the system of online submission of application forms for Combined Competitive (Prelim) Examination conducted by this Commission. This system was inaugurated by the then Hon'ble Chief Minister of Assam Sjt. Tarun Gogoi on 11th August, 2013 in presence of other dignitaries.

After introducing Online submission of application, 4 (four) nos. Examination were held under this facility. For the C.C. Prelims Exam/2013, C.C. Prelims Exam/2014, C.C. Prelims Exam/2015 and Jr. Administrative Assistant Exam/2015 for the Commission office, application were

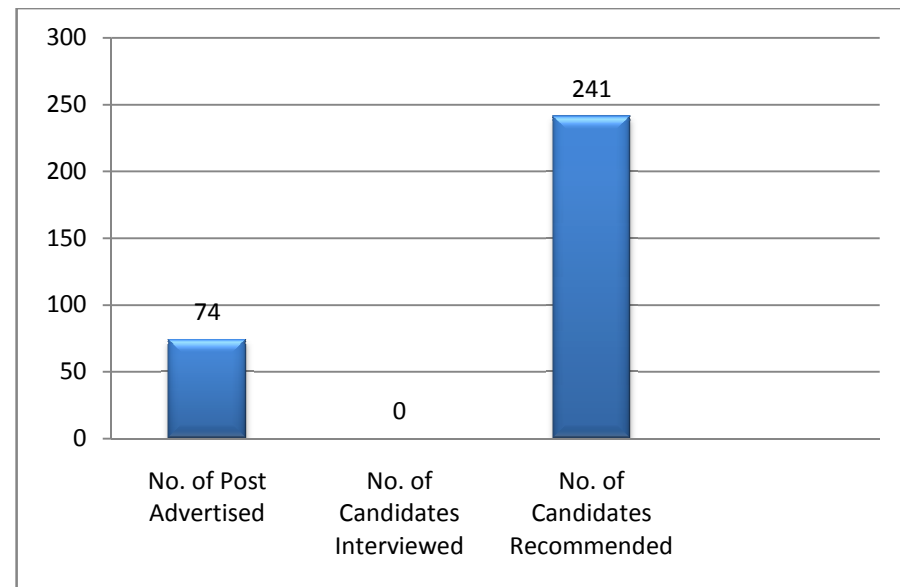
submitted through online mode. Altogether 1,63,422 nos. of application were received for 3(three) C.C. Prelim Examination and 8,945 nos. of application were received for Jr. Administrative Assistant Examination.

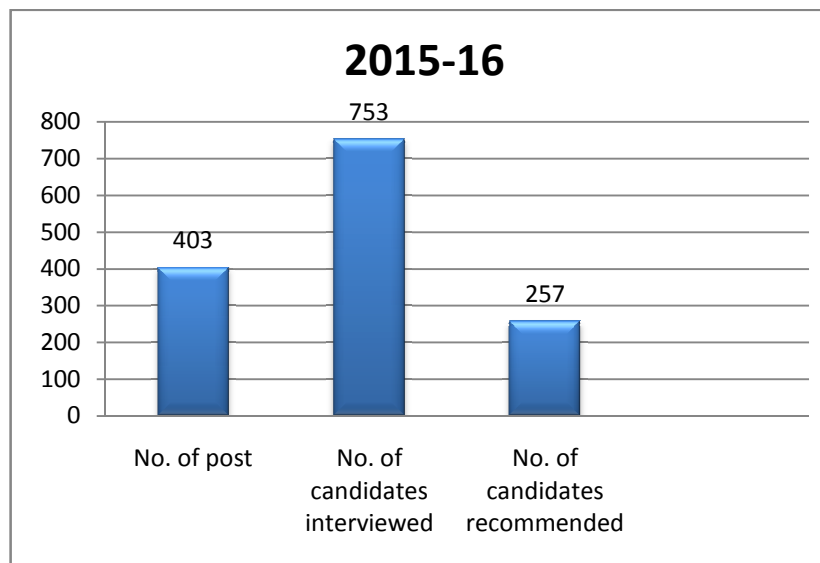
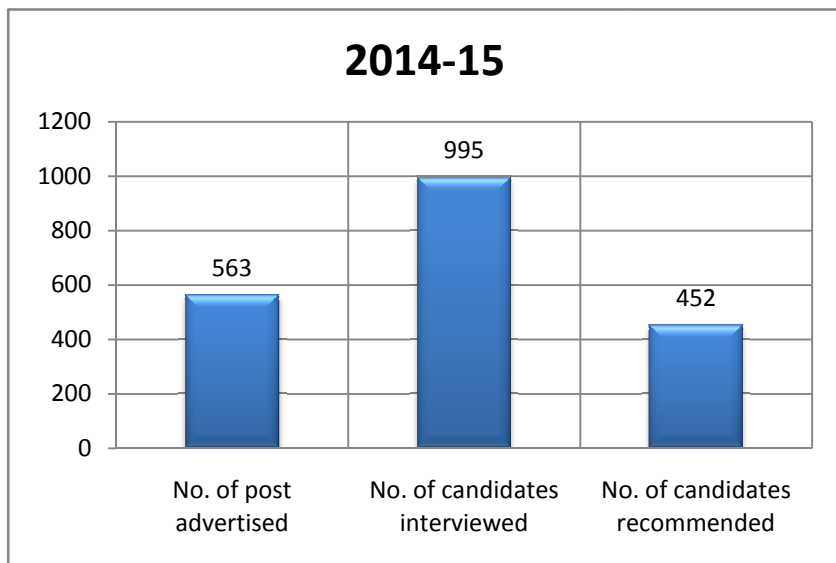

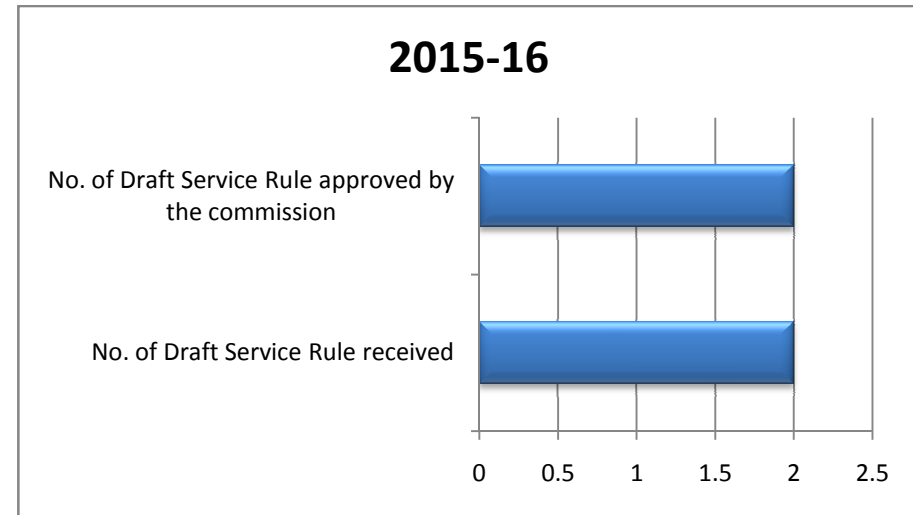
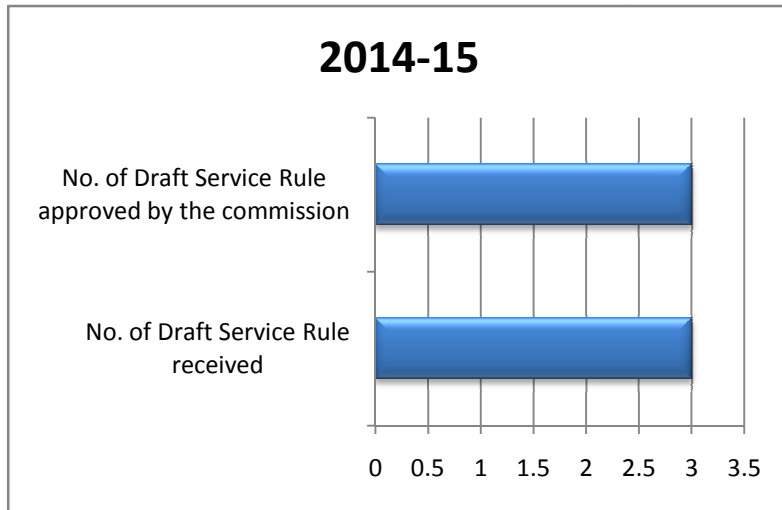
No. of Post advertised, No. of candidates interviewed and No. of candidates recommended in the year 2014-15 and 2015-16 in the area of Direct Recruitment.

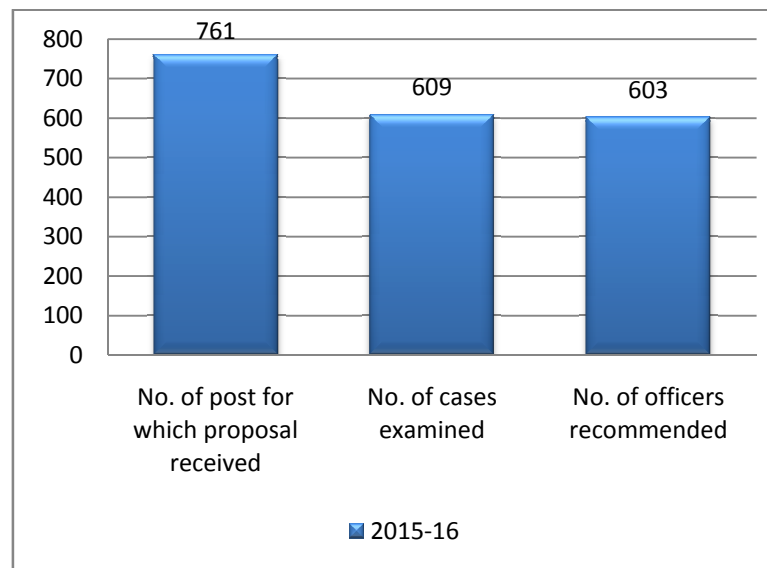
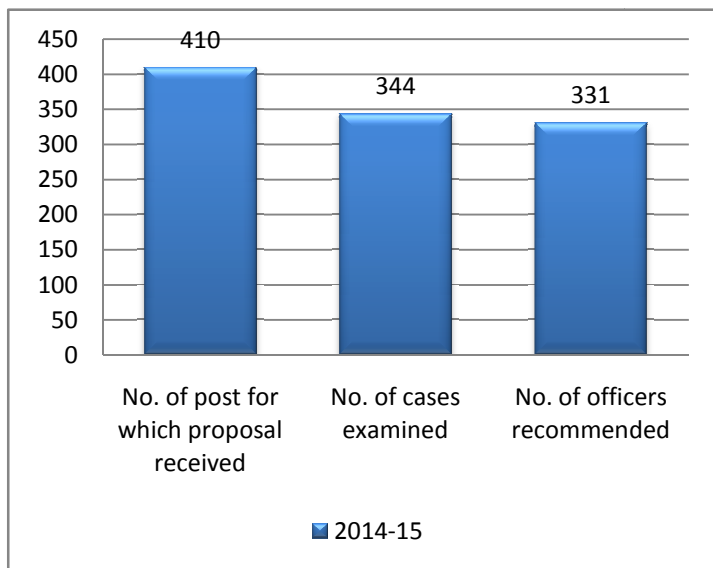
Draft Service Rule

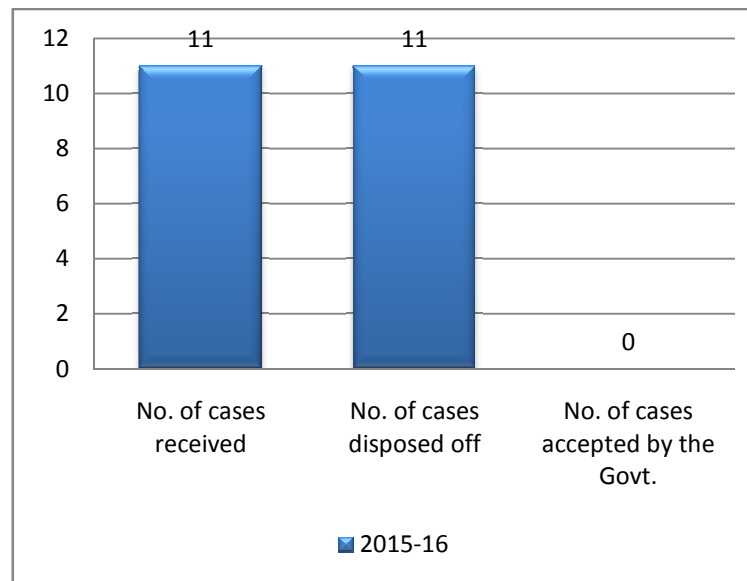

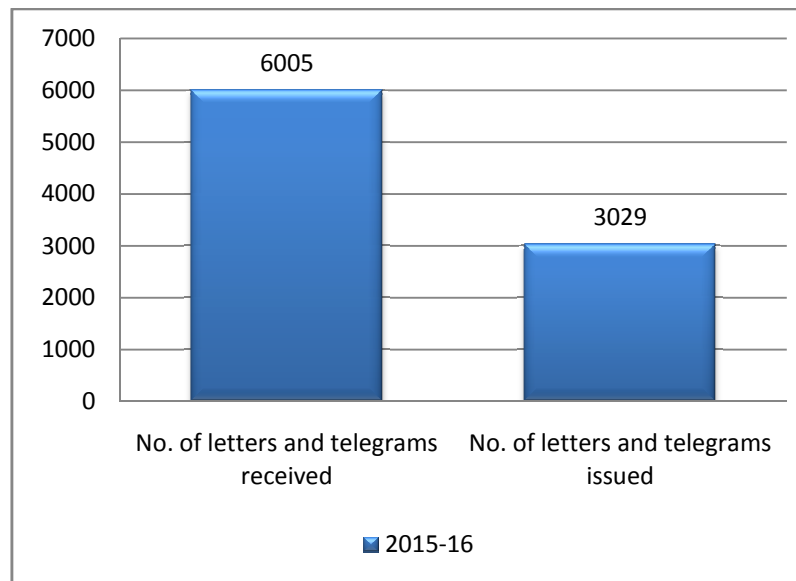
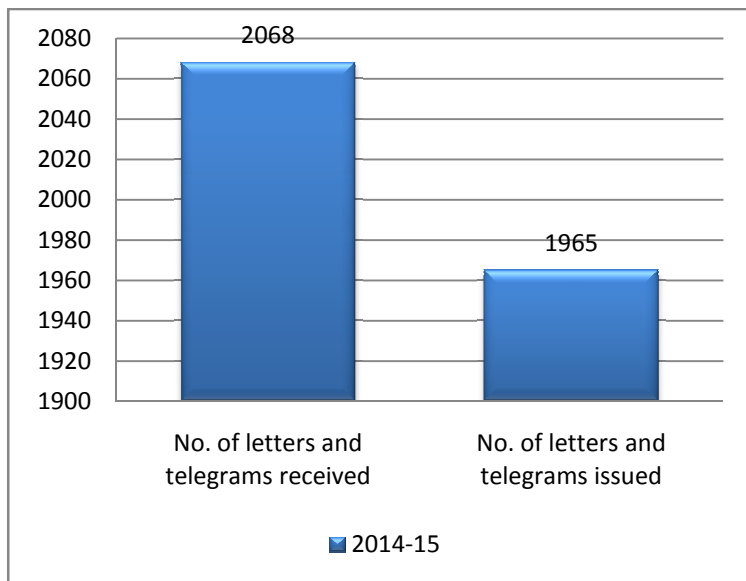
Disciplinary and Appeal Cases

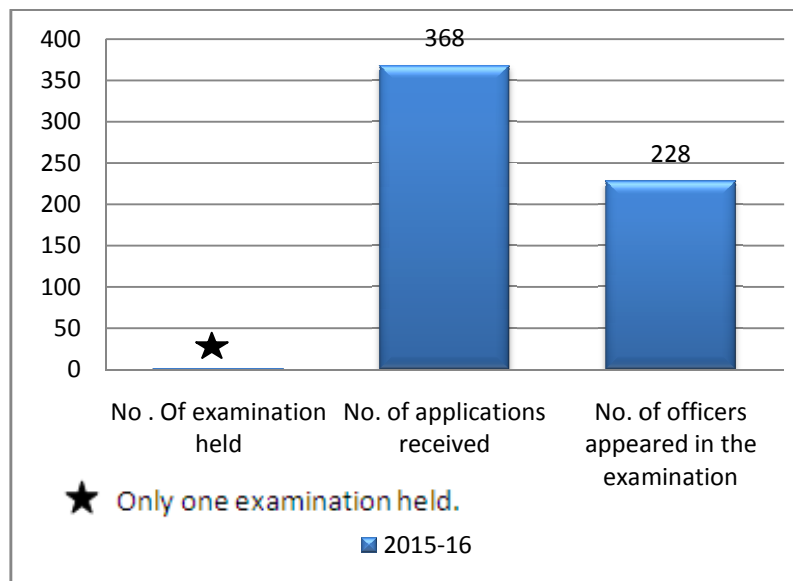

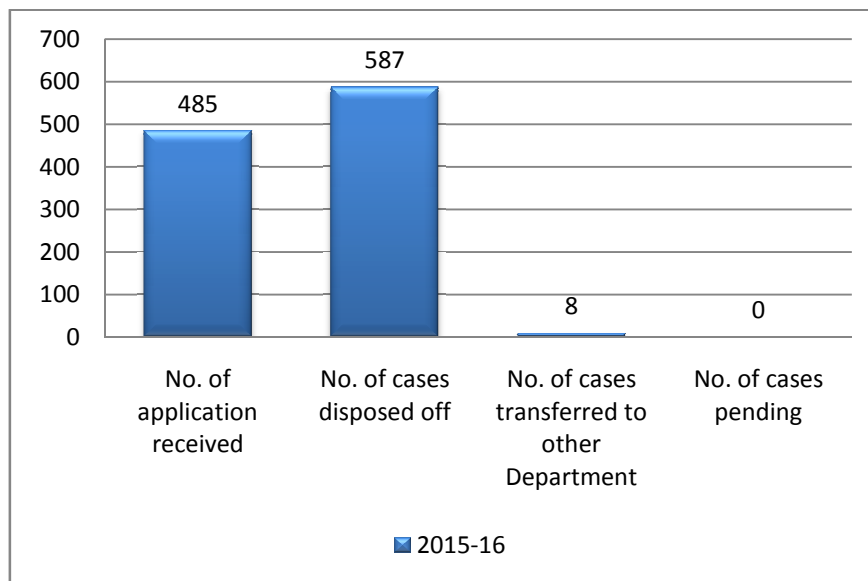
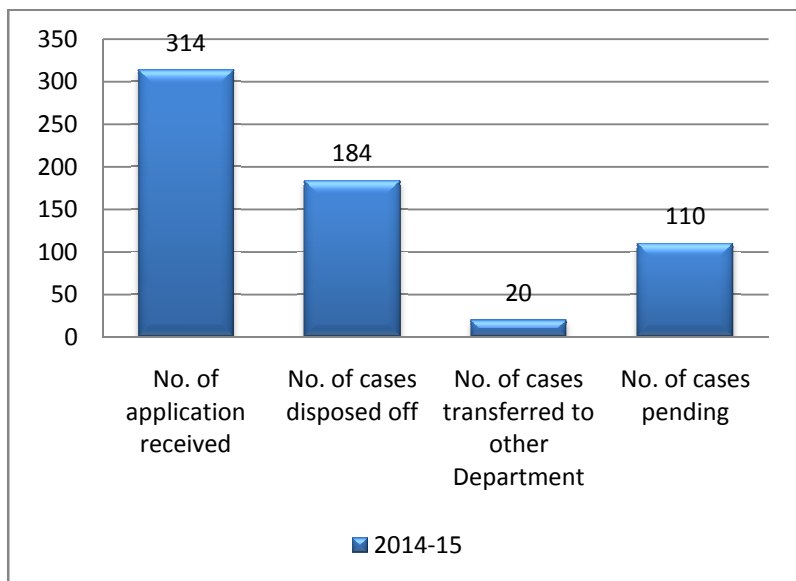
Half Yearly Departmental Examination

CHAPTER – 7

ESTABLISHMENT BRANCH AND ITS FUNCTIONS

CHAPTER – 7
ESTABLISHMENT BRANCH

One of the major wings of the Commission is the Establishment Branch. The Establishment Branch deals with the general administration of the office, transfer, promotion, posting and other service matters of the staff etc. Appointment of staff in the office of the Commission is done by the Establishment Branch. There is an enquiry office attached to the office of the Commission assisted by an Assistant and an office attendant. It is under the Establishment wing. It is enquiry section functions from 10 AM to 5 PM on all working days. It furnishes the primary information to the candidates and visitors and also issue of passes to outsiders who come to the office to visit the for official matters. The Branch also issues passes to the visitors with permission from the Commission to visit the Chairman and the Members.

The security personnel who are engaged in the Commission by the Government are directly under the control of Establishment Branch. They have to perform their duties round the clock shift wise. Without their permission no outsider is allowed to enter inside the office premises. The security of the office building including prevention of theft and unauthorized entry are the responsibilities of the security personnel.

RECRUITMENT BY EXAMINATION

CHAPTER-8

RECRUITMENT BY WRITTEN EXAMINATION

A.GENERAL OBSERVATION ON THE METHOD OF RECRUITMENT THROUGH EXAMINATION:

The scheme and syllabi of various examinations for selection through written examination coupled with viva-voce test are governed by the provisions of respective Service Rules. However, it is observed that most of the Service Rules were framed long back and hence the scheme and syllabi contained therein are also outdated in comparison to the changing scenario in every walk of life. The present technological human mind is pushing forward new challenges in the sphere of good governance. The Commission feels that the age old schemes and syllabi of various examinations are required to be reviewed to cope with the new age necessities.

REVISION OF SCHEME AND SYLLABI FOR COMBINED COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION :

- The Commission in conformity with its mooted objective decided in principle to carry on a continuing process to review the scheme and syllabi of Combined Competitive Examination (C.C. Exam). A major change in the Scheme & Syllabi of C.C. Exam. Was brought last during 1989, as per the provision of Assam Public Services Combined Competitive Examination Rules, 1989. The Assam Public Service Commission will hold Combined Competitive Examination in two stages namely Preliminary Examination (meant to serve as a screening test only) and Main Examination comprising of written and interview for the selection of candidate for various services & posts in accordance with the rules and procedures prescribed.
- Introduction of OMR (Optical Mark Readable) Answer Sheet in the Preliminary Exam. Of C.C. Exam. 2009 onwards is another step of the Commission to cope with the changing scenario. The Commission as contemplated to do away with the offline submission of application form in C.C. Prelim. Exam. introduced online submission of the same in C.C. Prelim. Exam. 2013 onwards, which would gradually be extended to cover other selections also including selections under Direct Recruitment by the Commission.

NEED FOR PROPER ASSESMENT OF VACANCIES:

- 2.2. The Commission observes that cases continue to occur where some of the departments did not intimate the actual number of vacancies meant for reserved categories for being included in the Commission's notice of the Examinations/Interviews for the information of the prospective candidates. As a result in respect of some of the Examinations/Interviews the number of such vacancies notified initially is to be modified/reviewed during the pendency of the selection creating hurdles in the process. The Commission feels that assesment of all vacancies including vacancies for reserved

- categories should be made meticulously at the very initial exercise to avoid complicity in future.

USE OF INDIAN LANGUAGE IN COMBINED COMPETITIVE (MAIN) EXAMINATION:

- 2.3 In the Combined Competitive (Main) Examination the candidates have to answer in the medium of English in all papers including General Studies

However, those candidates who opt to write in Assamese in Optional papers are also allowed to do so.

- EXAMINATION WING:

2.4. The conduct of various Competitive Examinations for selection to various services and posts being one of the principal activities of the Commission, great importance is attached to the quality, efficiency and reliability of the Examination process. This necessitates a constant monitoring of the Examination process, methodology and allied matters. To facilitate this, an Examination Confidential wing is in action in the Commission. The Commission maintains contact with other recruitment agencies, academic experts concerned with a view to keep abreast of the latest development in Assam and elsewhere in the field of Examination.

2.5. The Examination confidential wing has been instrumental in enabling the Commission to switch over smoothly from the conventional essay type to objective type papers with the introduction of OMR Answer Sheet to mark the responses in the Combined Competitive (Pre.) Examination etc. This has helped the Commission to cope with the phenomenal increase of the number of candidates in the aforesaid Examinations besides ensuring total objectivity in the evaluation process and timely declaration of results.

EXAMINATION HELD DURING THE YEAR:

2.6. 5 (Five) nos. of examination held during the year.

The CC (Main) Exam /2014 was held from 31st May, 2015 to 1st July, 2015 in Guwahati centre only. Altogether 2045 candidates were appeared in the said examination. Results were not declared during the year under report.

The examination for the post of Forest Ranger under Environmental and Forest Department was held from 30.09.2015 to 18.10.2015 at Guwahati centre only. Altogether 7052 applications were received but only 1343 nos. of candidates appeared in the said examination. Results were not declared during the year under report.

Examination (screening test) for the post of BDO under Panchayat and Rural Development was held on 27.09.2015 at Guwahati, Jorhat, Dibrugarh, Tezpur, Bongaigaon and Silchar centre. Altogether 22,031 nos. of applications were received but only 8493

candidates were appeared in the said examination. Results were not declared during the year under report.

The CC (Prelim) Exam/2015 was held on 3rd January, 2016 at 22 district headquarters of the state. Altogether 38,676 nos. of application received but only 17,856 nos. of candidate appeared in the said examination. Results are not declared during the year under report.

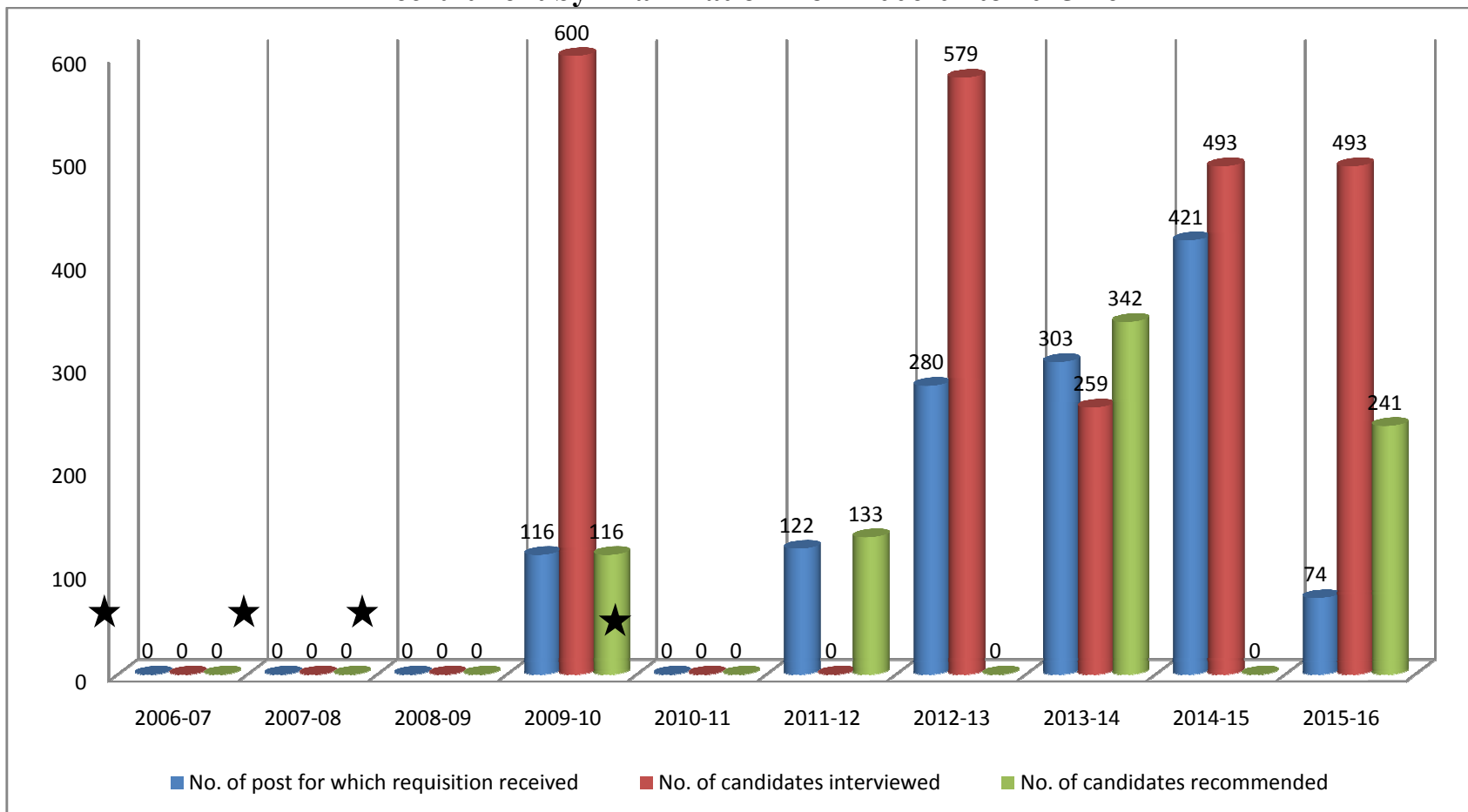
The examination for the post of Audit Officer (Promotion) under Finance (Estt. B) Department was held from 16.03.2016 to 19.03.2016 at Guwahati centre only. 27 nos. of application received but 20 nos. candidates were appeared in the said examination. Results were not declared during the year under report.

The Commission recommended 241 nos. of candidates for Civil and Allied Services Examination 2013 during the year under report. The caste wise breakup are SC-08, STP-20, STH-06, OBC/MOBC-80 and others 127. Among them 68 were women candidates.

Half-Yearly Departmental Examination:

2.7. The Half-Yearly Departmental Examination for officers belonging to IAS/IPS/ACS/APS etc. and various officers of other Departments was held in the month of February, 2016 in 5(five) centers viz. Guwahati, Jorhat, Tezpur, Silchar and Shillong. Altogether 368 officers applied for the Exam and 228 officers were appeared. Tribal language exam held at Guwahati centre only. The result of the said Exam was not declared during the year under the report.

No. of post advertised during last 10 years in the field of Examination by Interview.

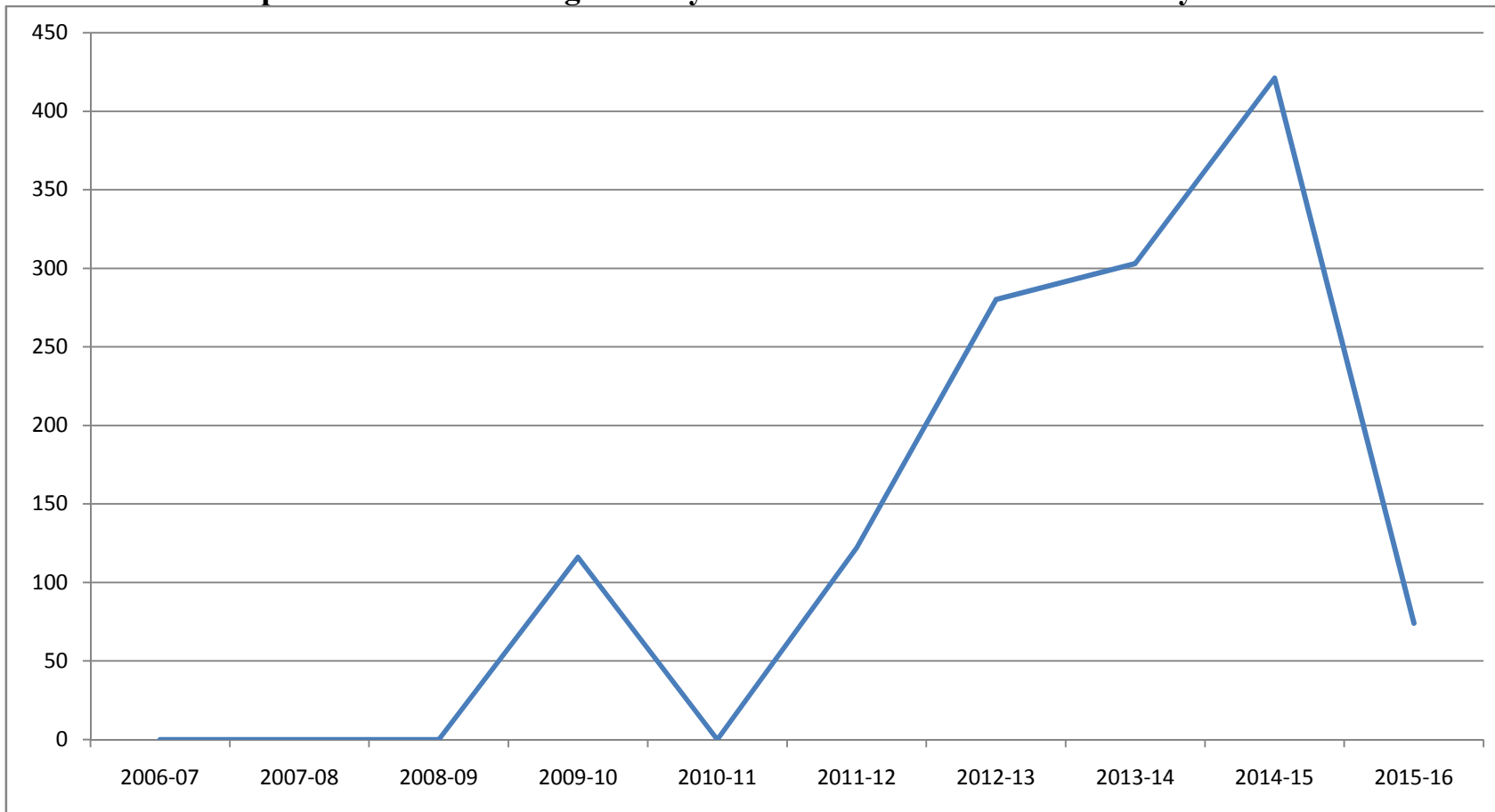

No. of candidates interviewed in the last 10 years in the field of Examination by Interview

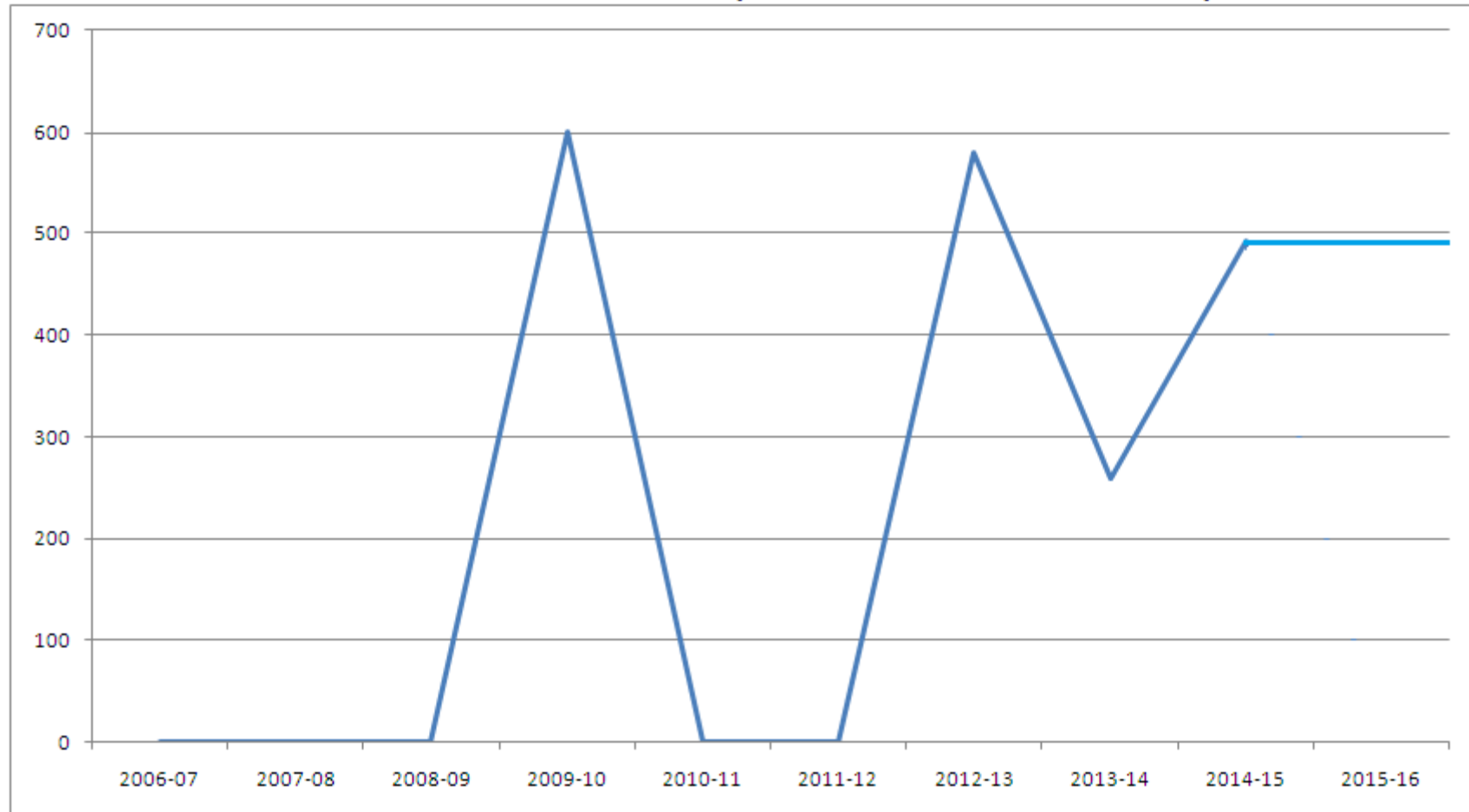
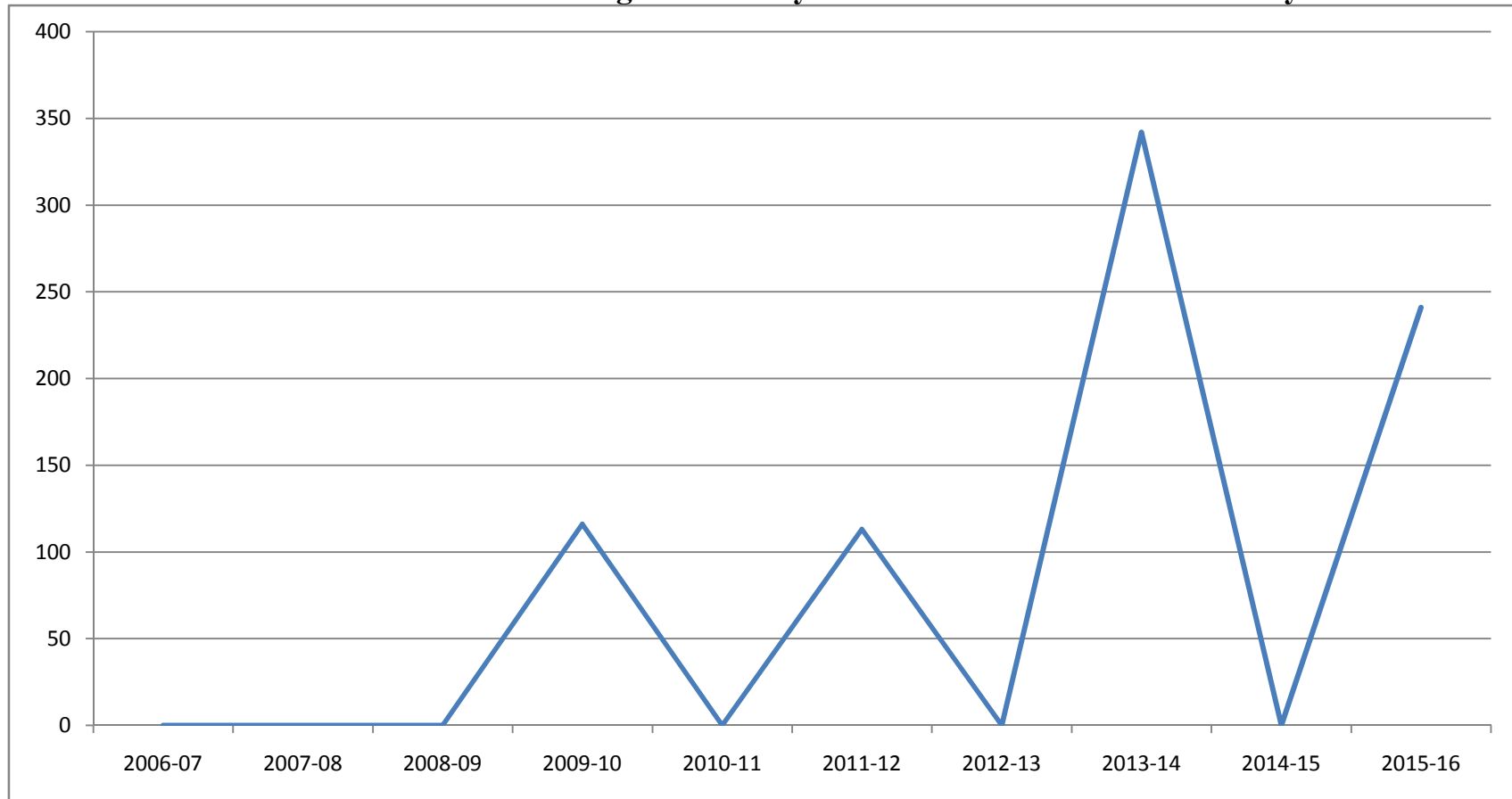


Diagram – 12

Direct Recruitment by Interview

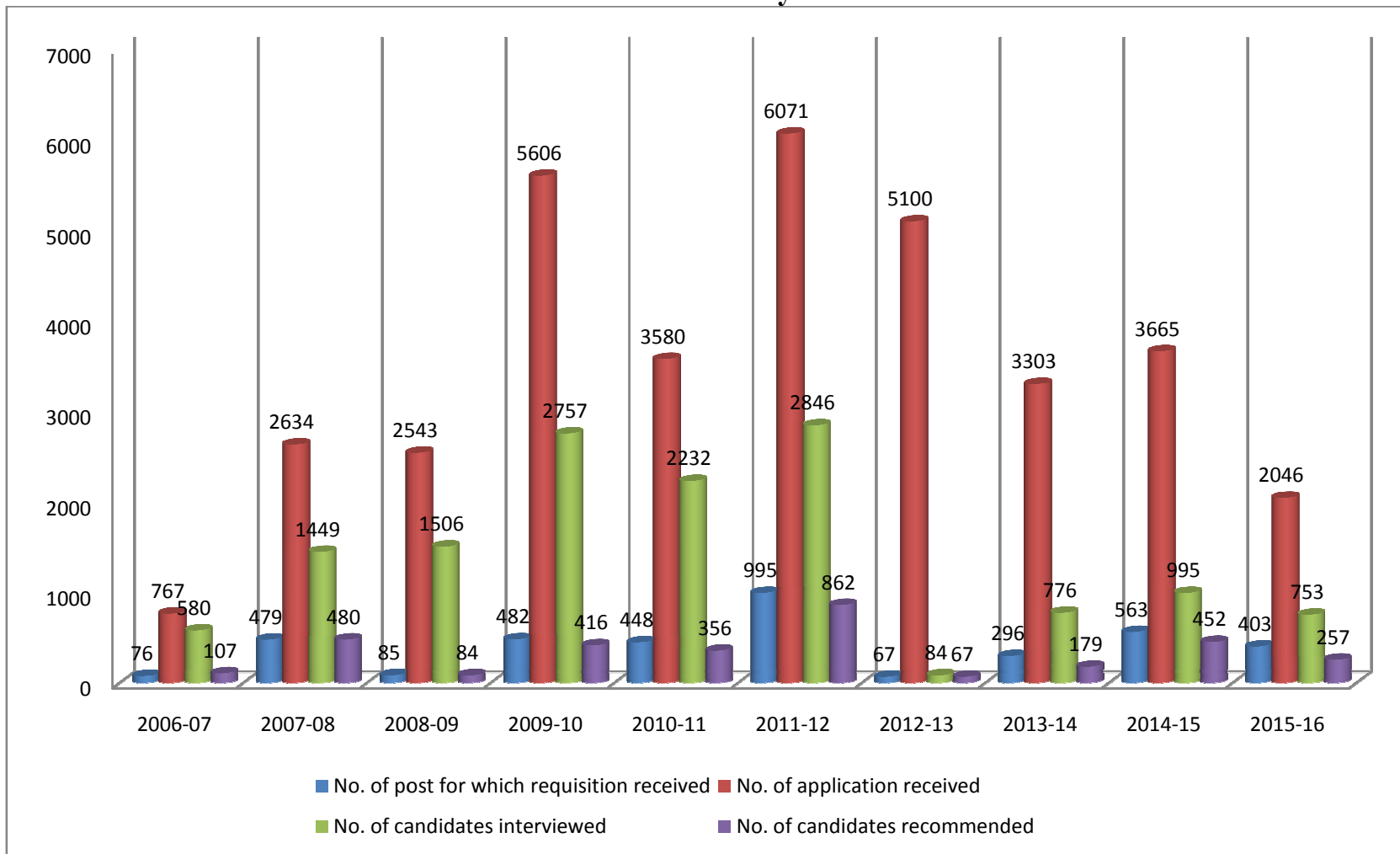

No. of post advertised during last 10 years in the field of Direct Recruitment.

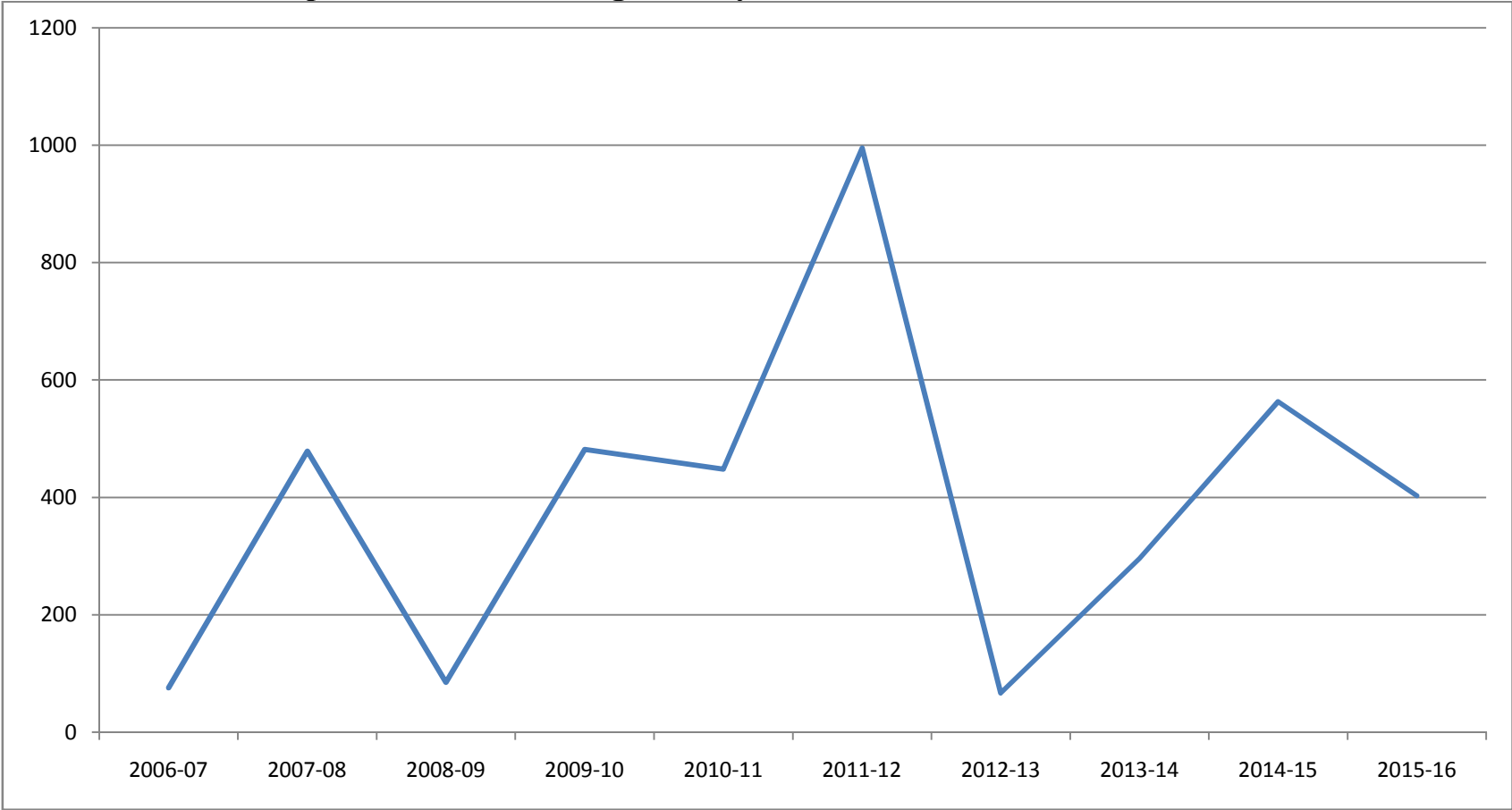

No. of candidates interviewed during the last 10 years in the field of Direct Recruitment

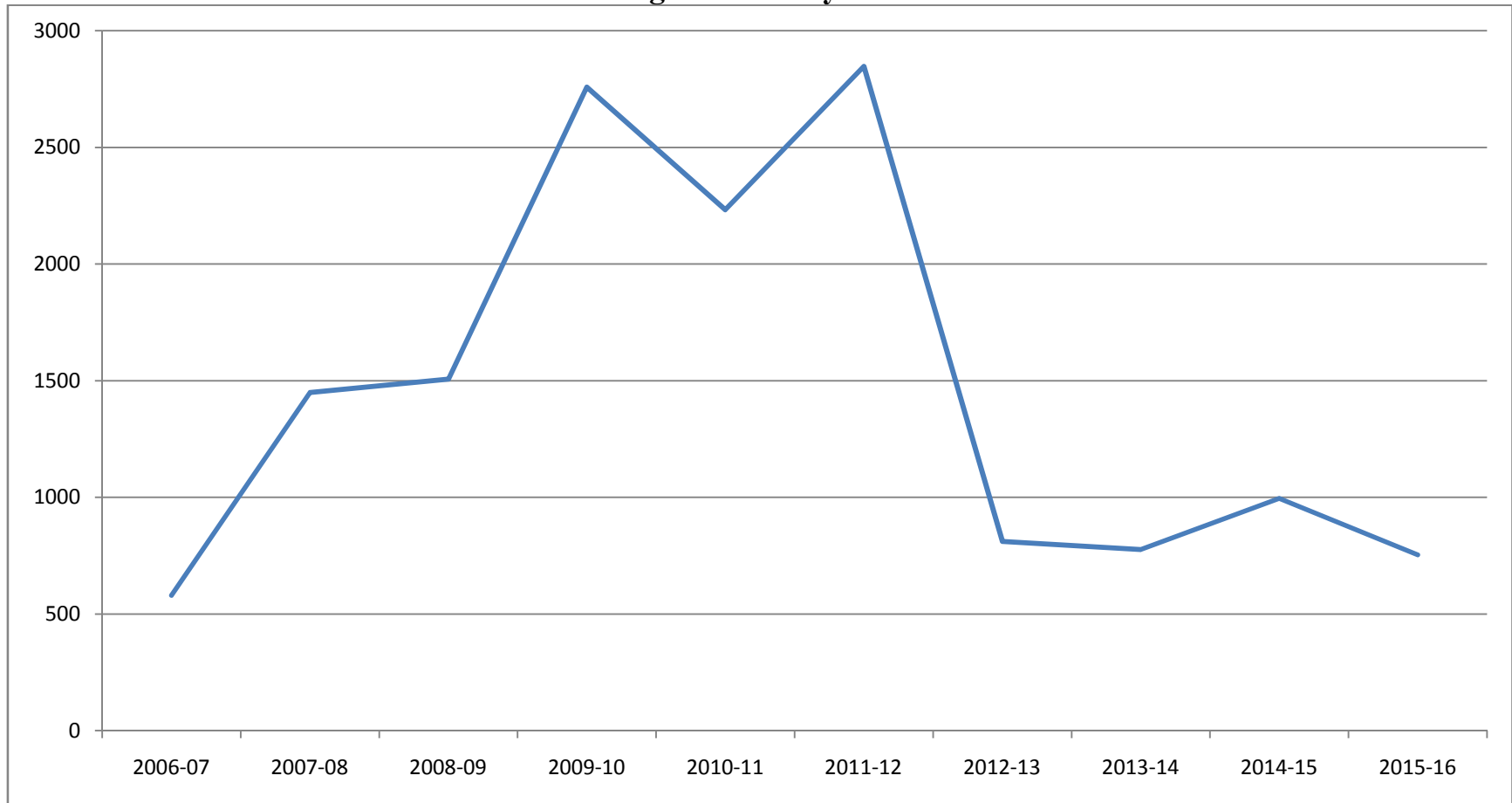
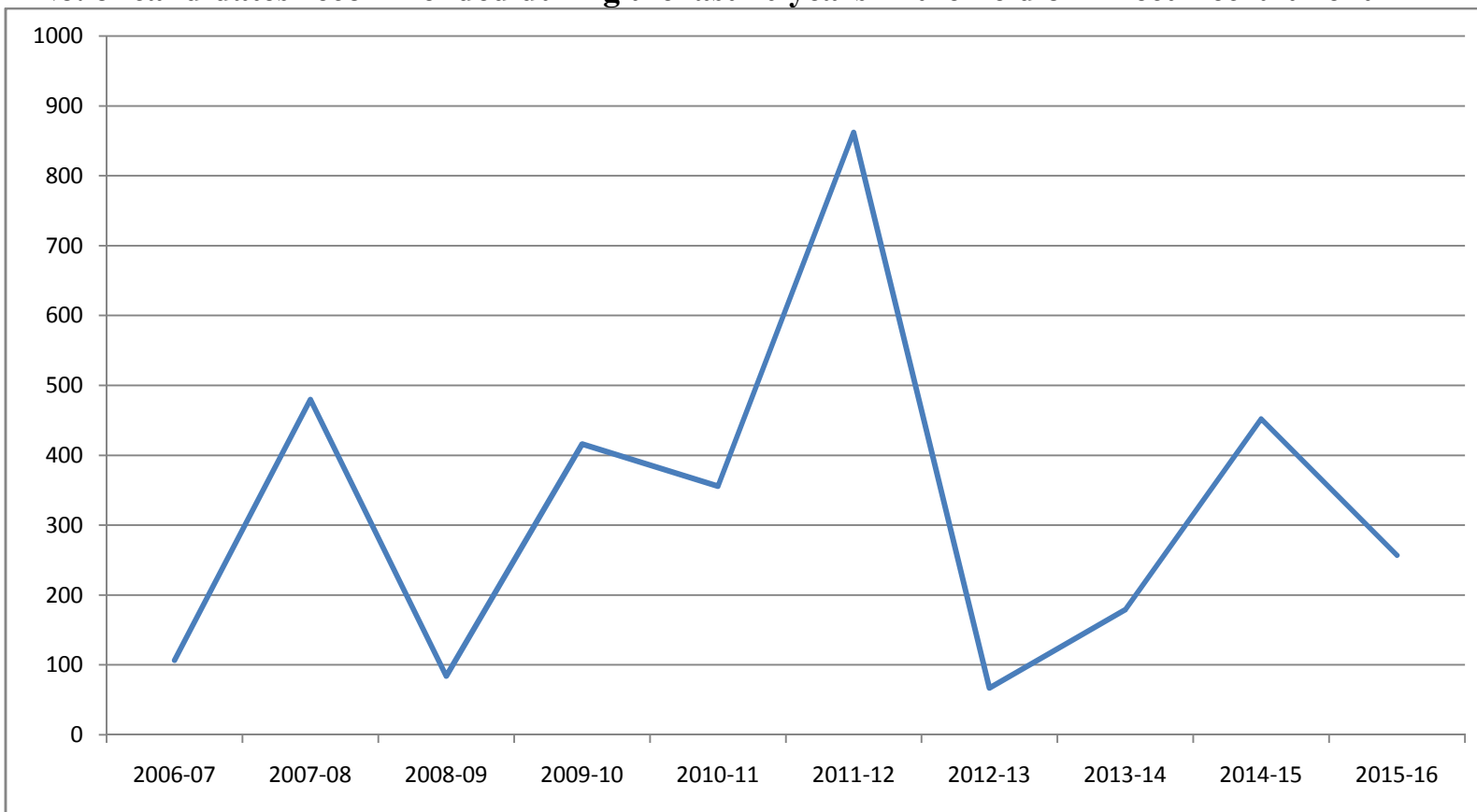


Diagram - 16

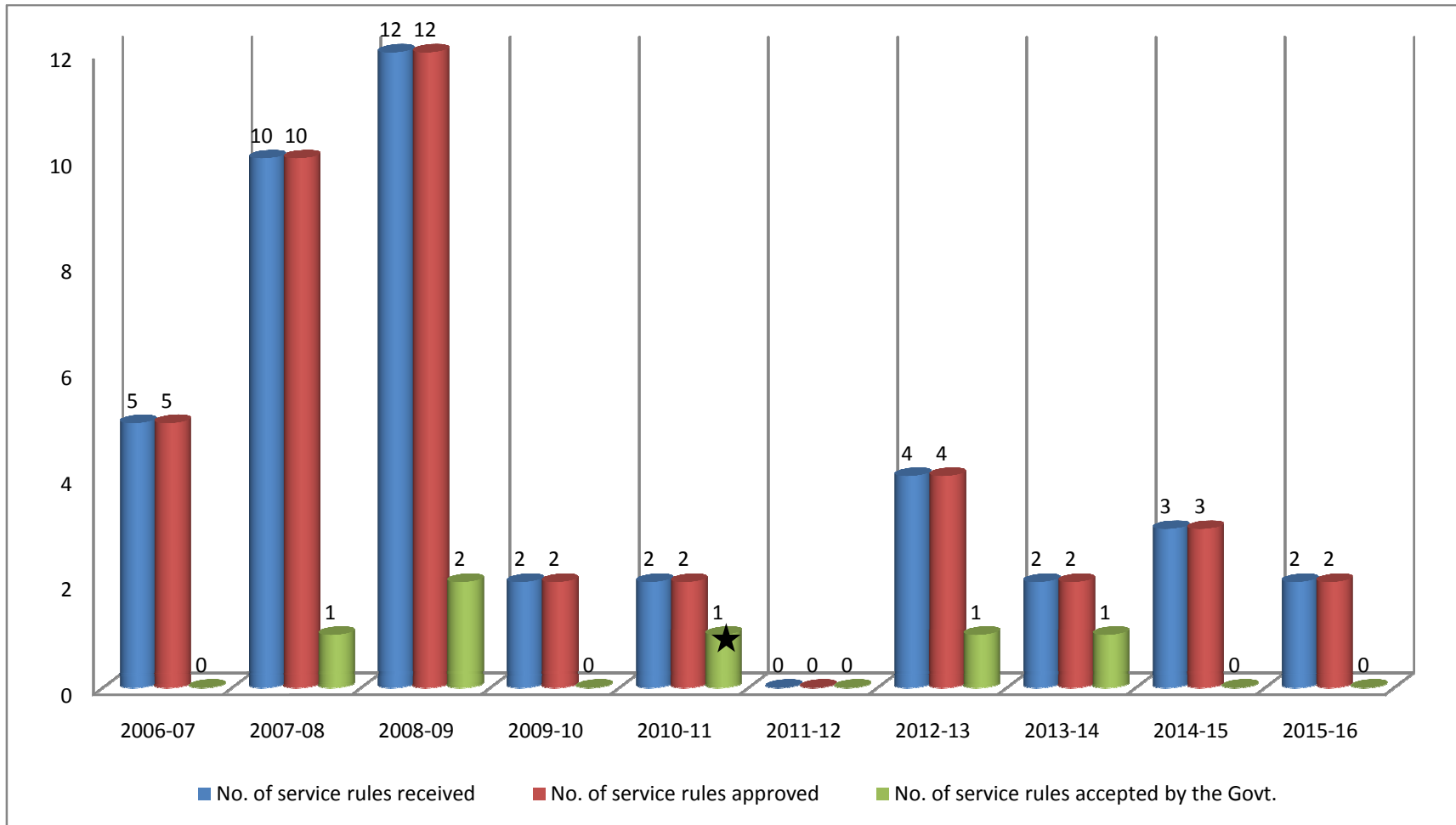

Promotion

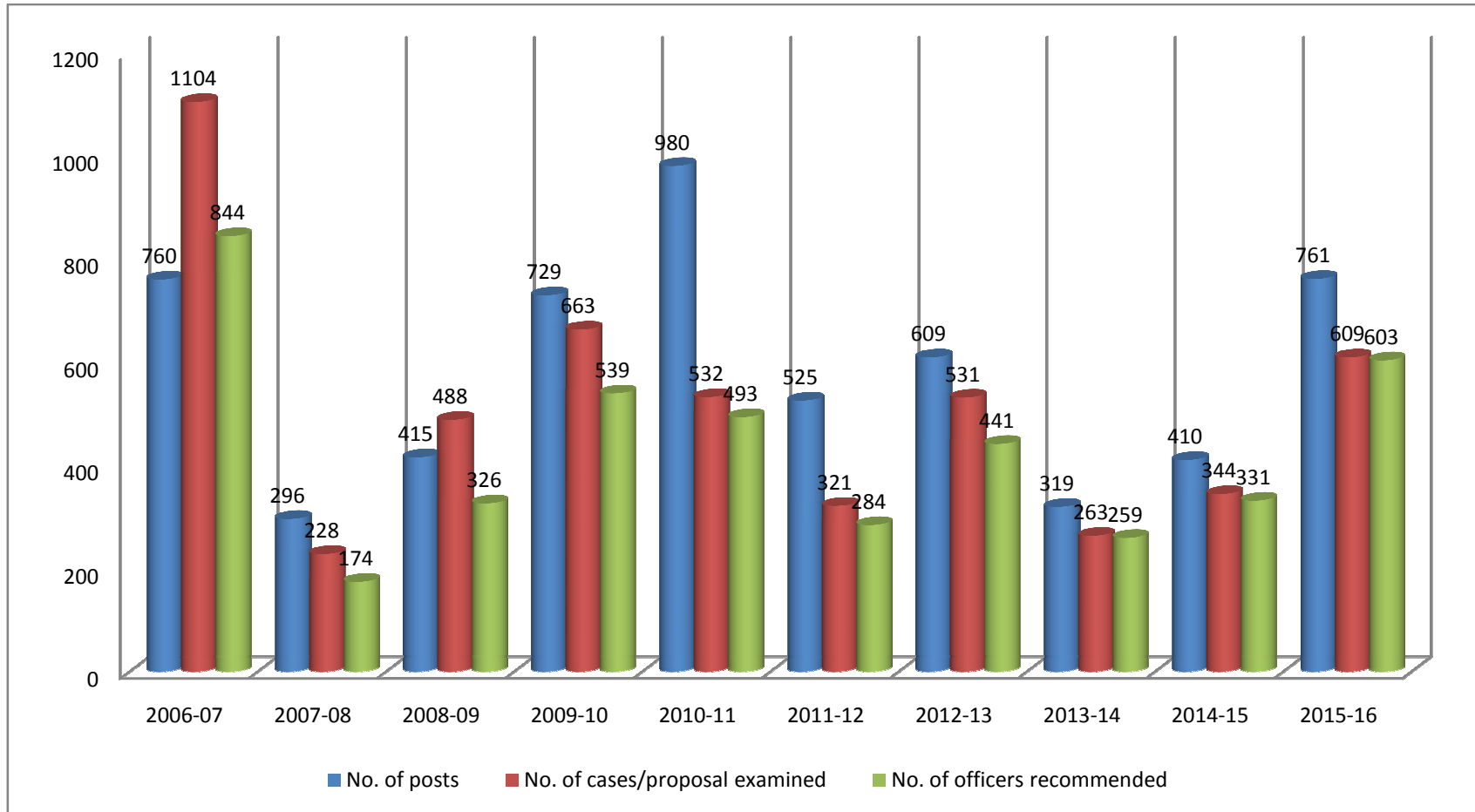

No. of post for which proposal received during the last 10 years in the field of promotion.

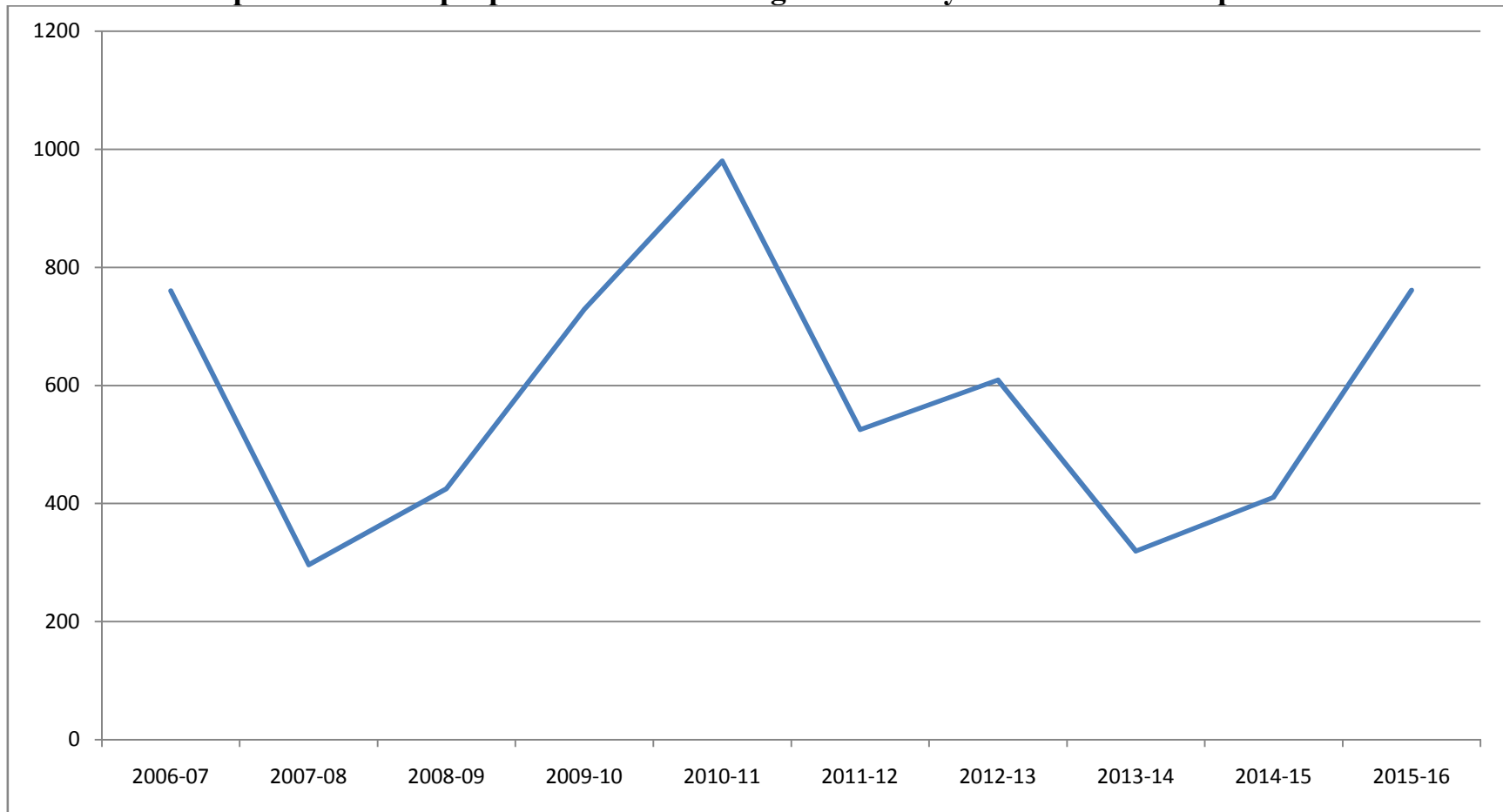

No. of proposal examined by the Commission during the last 10 years in the field of Promotion.

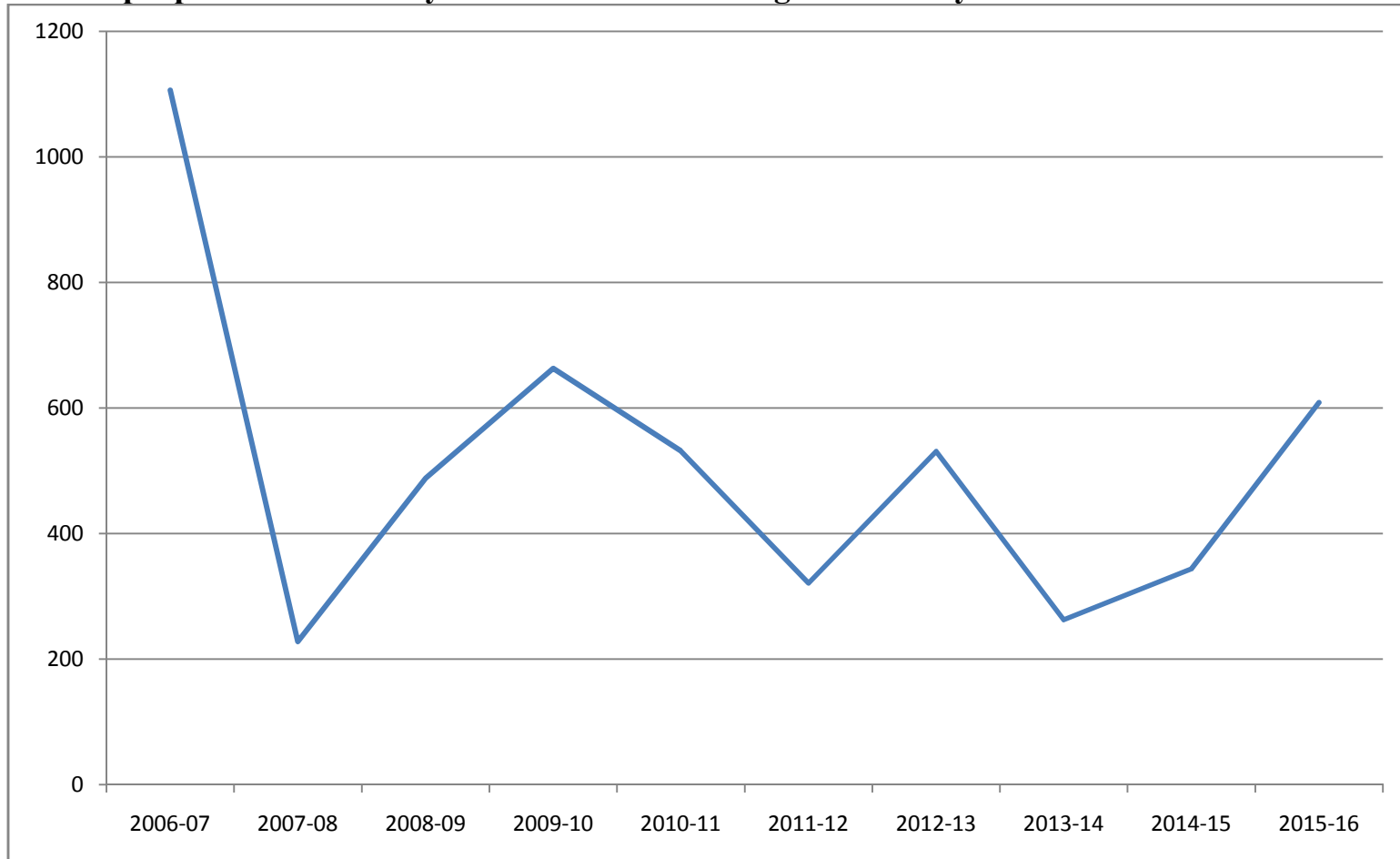
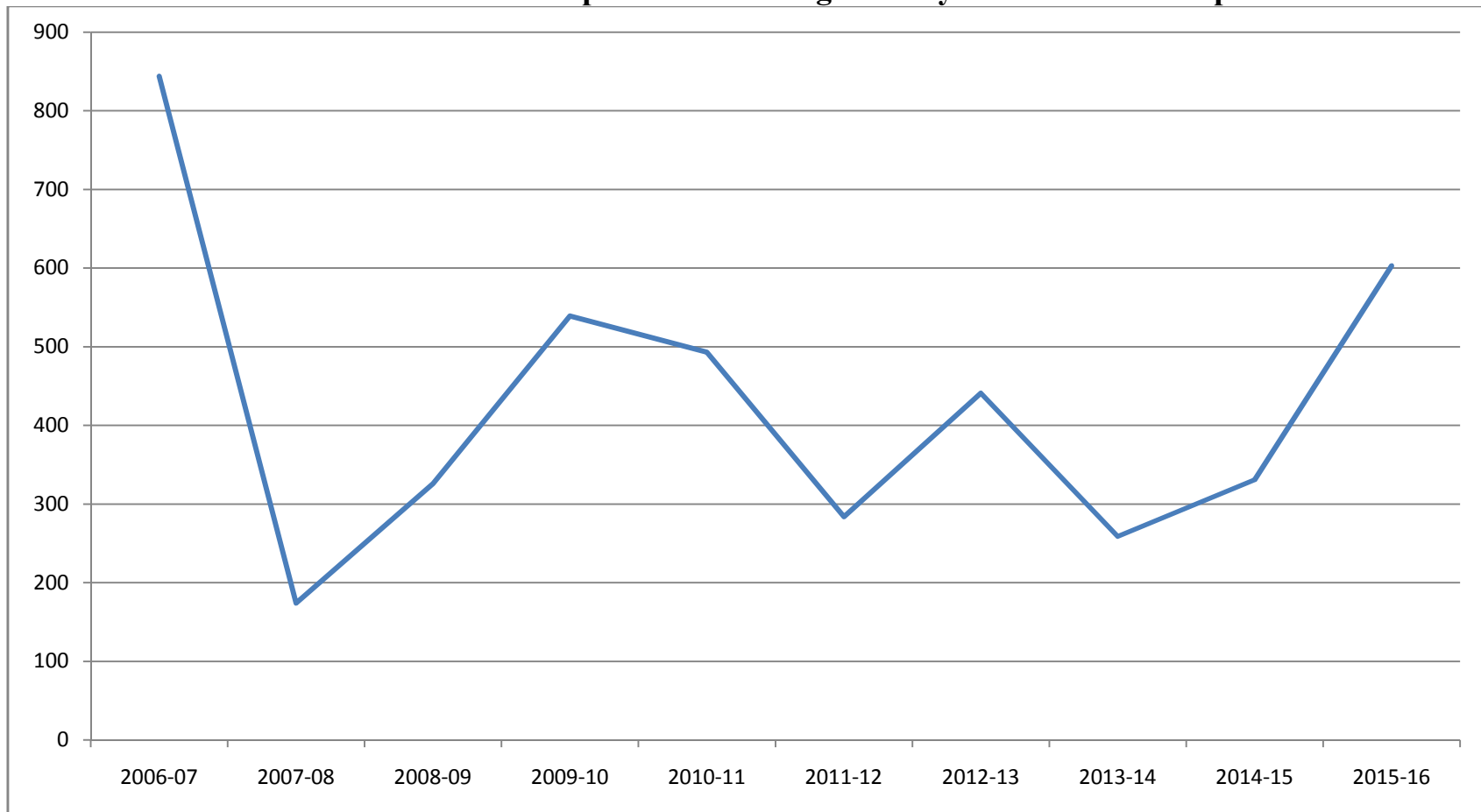

Disciplinary and Appeal Cases

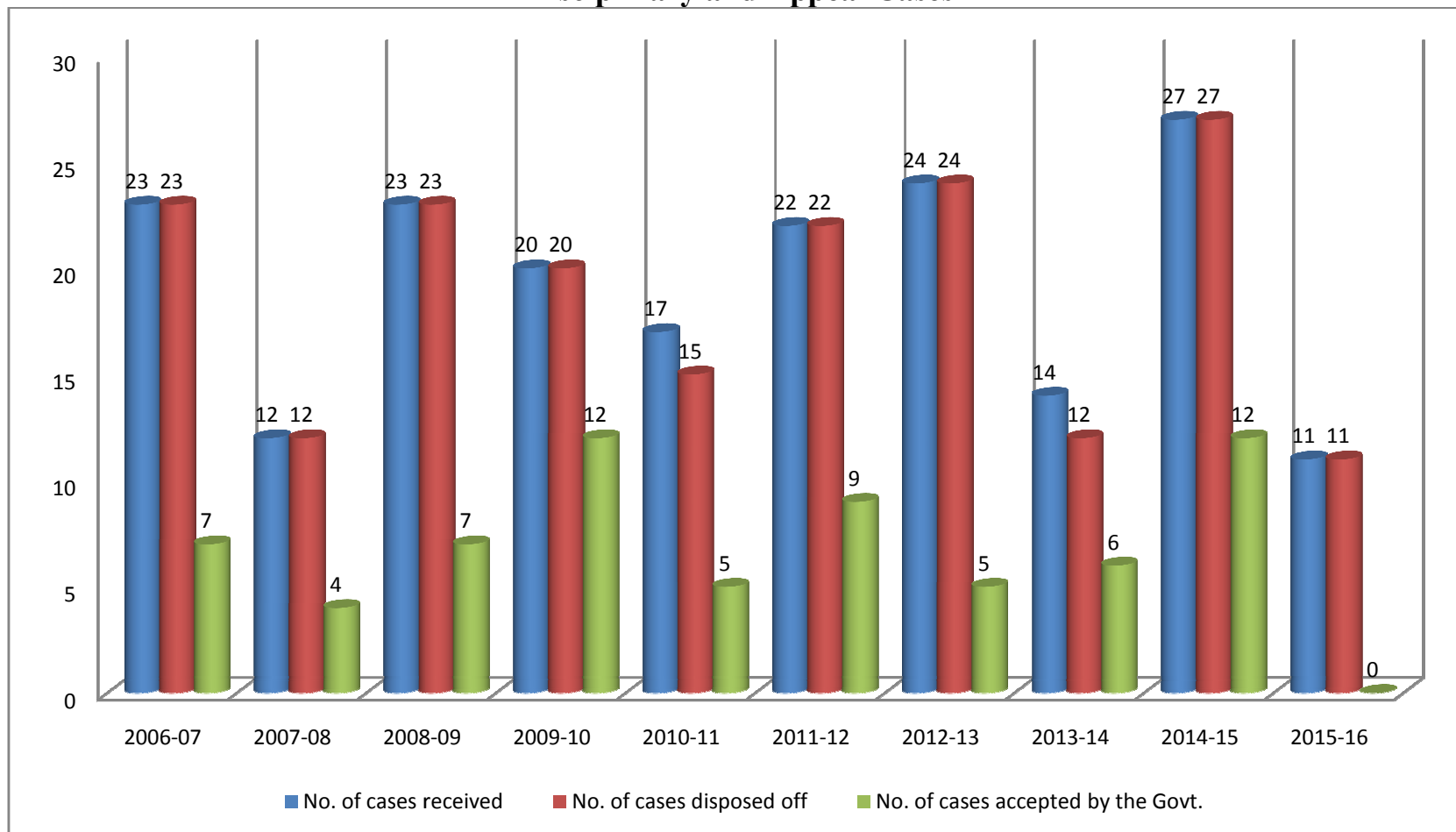

No. of disciplinary and appeal cases received during the last 10 years

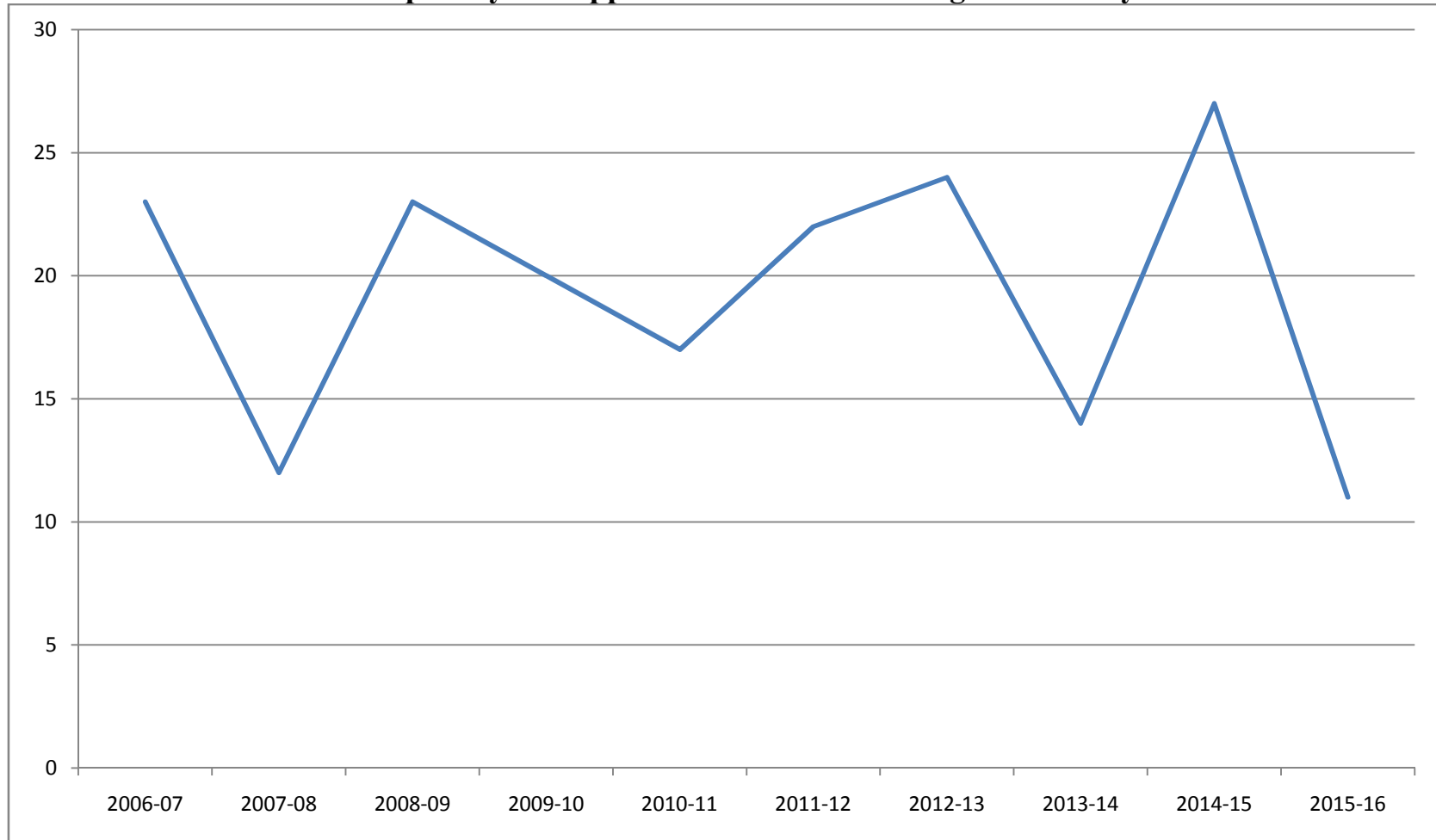
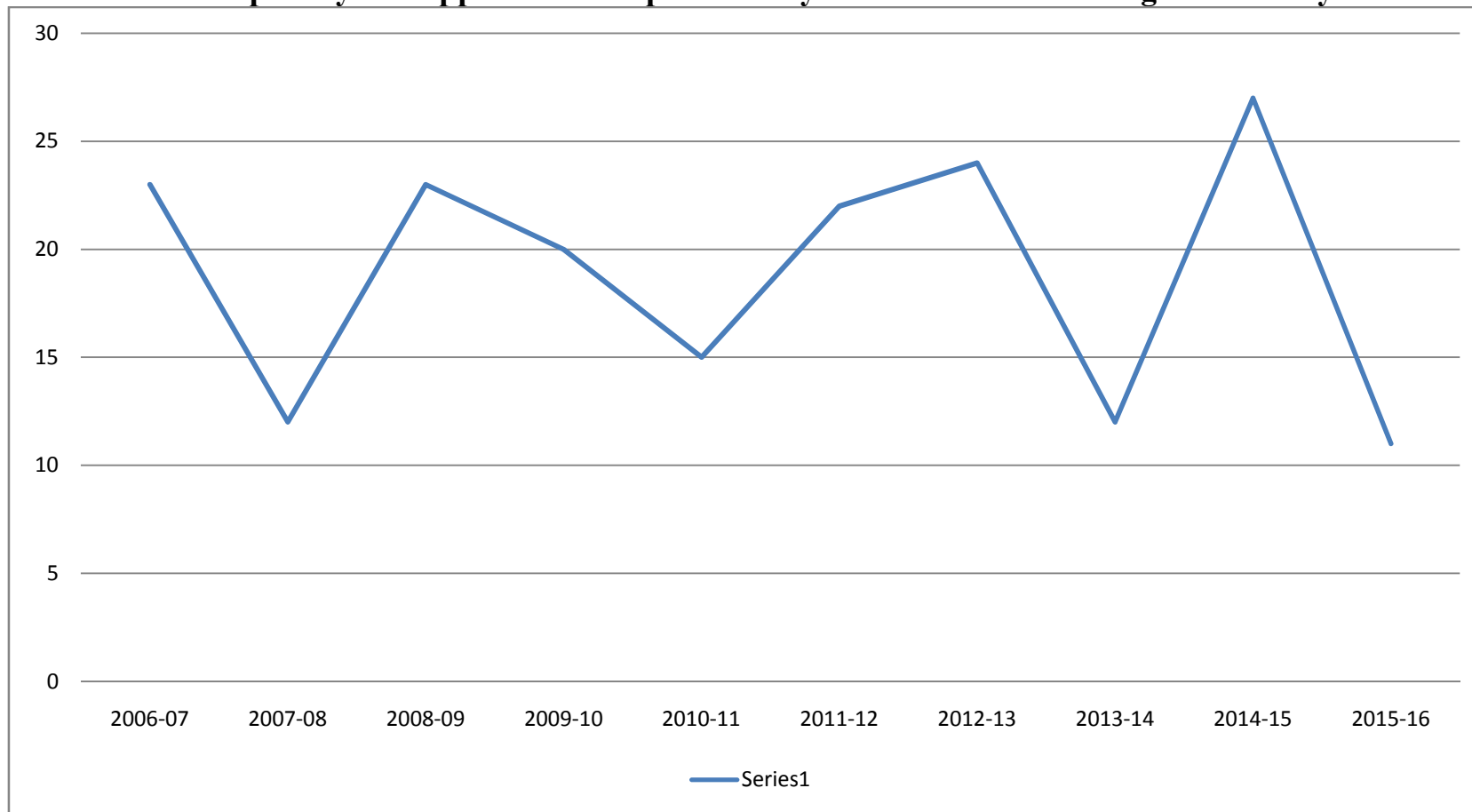

RTI Cases

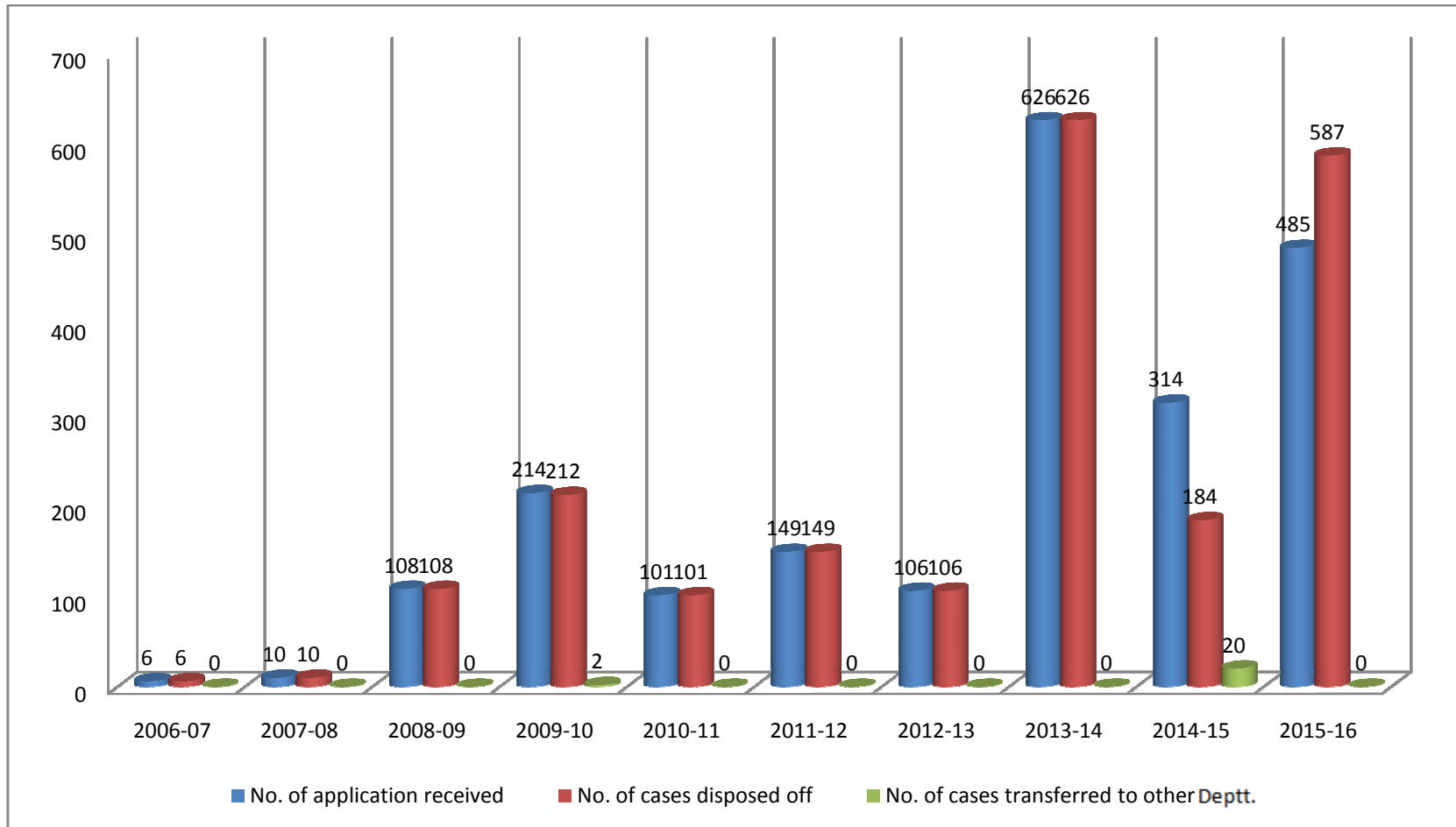
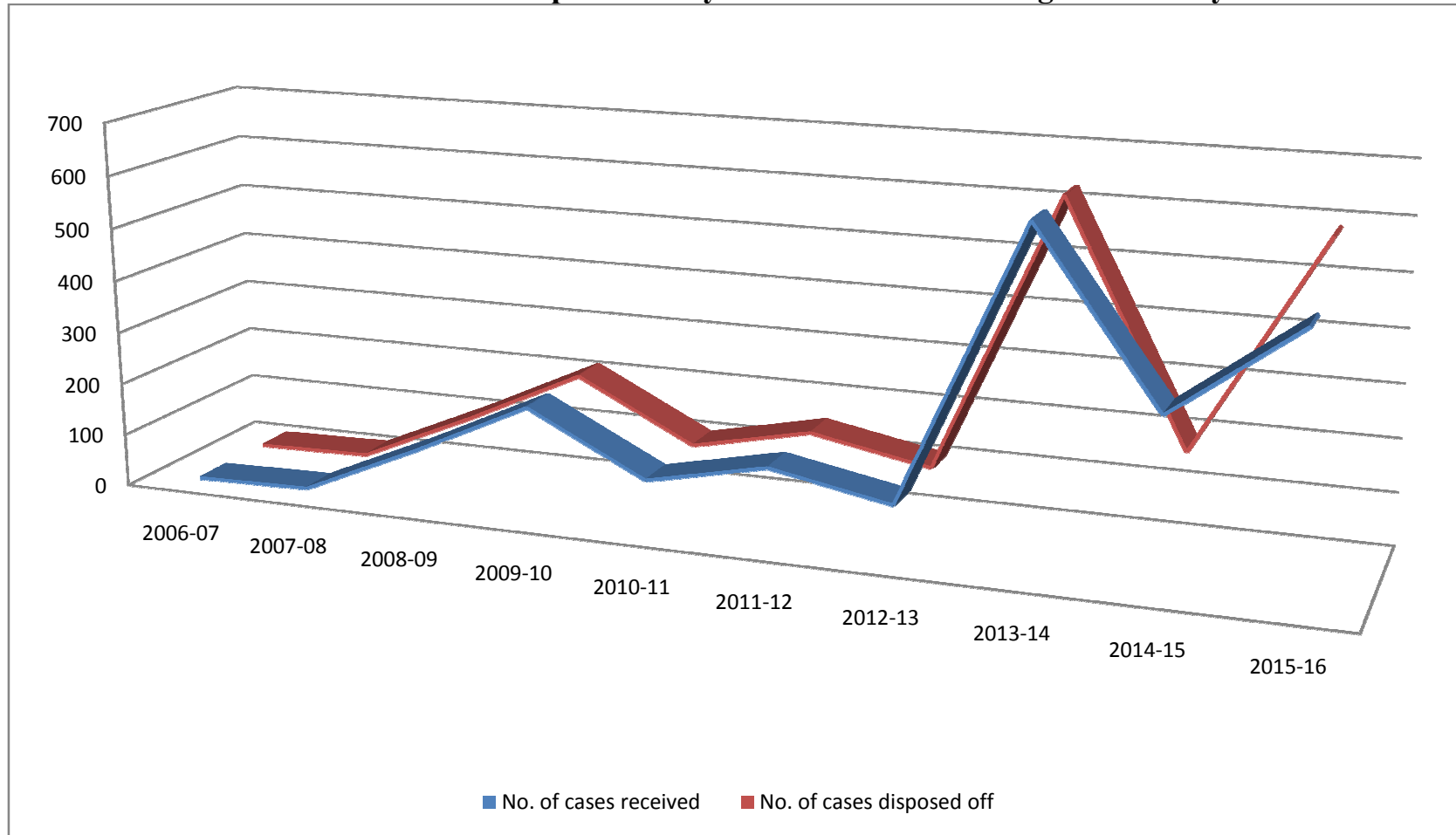

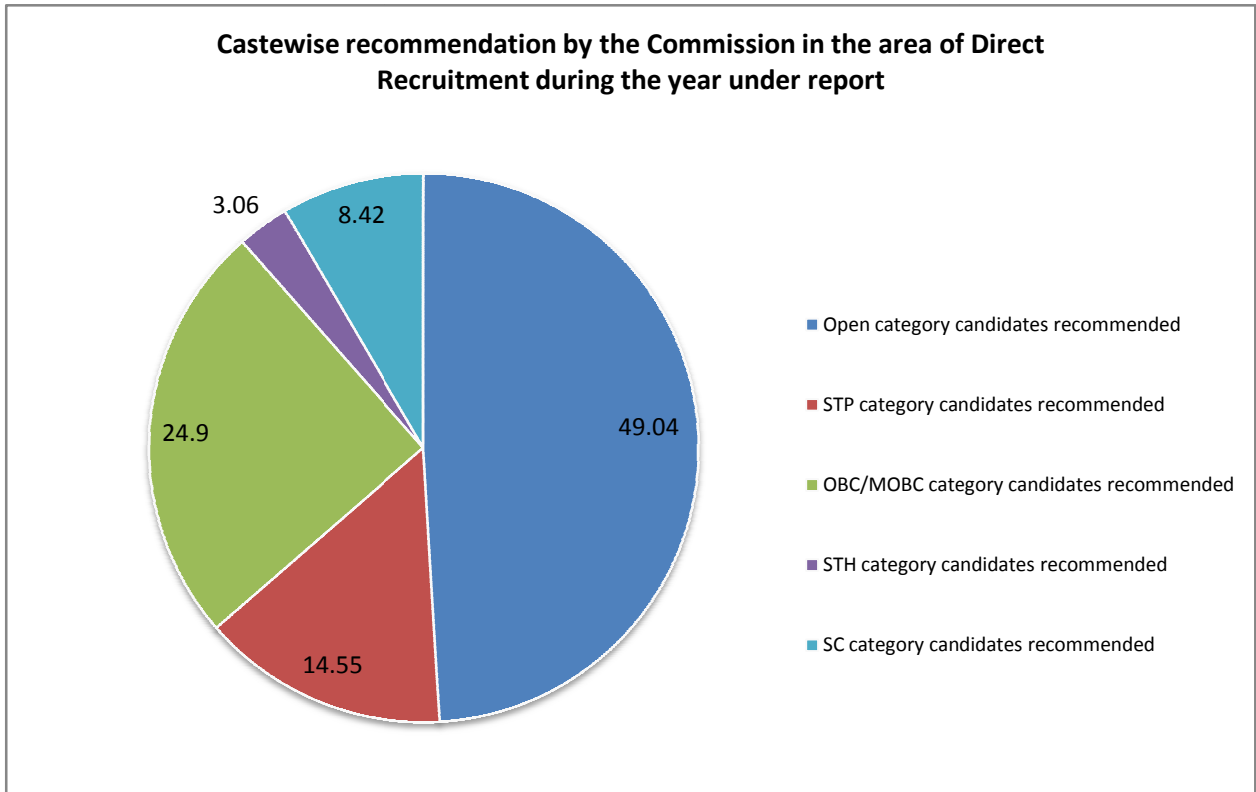
