REVISED INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES FOR THE COMBINED COMPETITIVE (MAINS) EXAMINATION, 2020

In supercession of the previous instructions issued with the e-Admission Certificates, candidates of the Combined Competitive (Mains) Examination, 2020 are hereby informed that:

- 1. Candidature of all candidates is provisional and subject to cancellation at any stage, if found ineligible during the recruitment process. They are expected to maintain decorum and strictly comply with all rules / instructions for smooth conduct of the examination at all times.
- 2. Candidates should note that the Commission will take up the verification of eligibility conditions i.e. **age, educational qualification** and **category** etc. with reference to the original documents, only during document verification before the Interview.
- 3. Candidates are advised to reach Examination Venue 1 (one) hour before commencement of the Examination. The Examination Hall will open 30 minutes before the scheduled commencement of the Examination in each session and close 20 minutes after the scheduled commencement of the Examination. No candidate shall be allowed entry into the Examination Venue after closure of the entry.
- 4. The e-Admission certificate should be checked carefully and discrepancy (ies), if any, should be brought to the notice of APSC immediately.
- 5. Candidates must bring a print out copy of the e-Admission Certificate, along with the (original) Photo Identity Card, in each session to secure admission to the Examination Venue/Hall. No candidate will be allowed to sit in the examination unless he/she is in possession of the e-Admission certificate for the examination.
 - <u>Photo Identity Card includes</u>: PAN Card/Driving License/Passport/Voter ID/AADHAR Card/IDs issued by Govt. Departments/PSUs etc. **Photo id cards issued by private institutions, companies etc. will NOT be accepted.**
- 6. The e-Admission certificate must be preserved by the candidates, till the declaration of the final result.
- 7. The Candidates are responsible for safe custody of the e-Admission Certificate and in the event of any other person using this e-Admission Certificate, the onus lies on them to prove that they have not used the services of any impersonator(s)
- 8. Candidates are advised not to bring any valuables/costly items in the Examination Halls as safe keeping of the same cannot be assured. The Commission will not be responsible for any loss in this regard.
- 9. Possession (even in switch off mode) / use of Mobile Phones, smart watches and other Electronics / Communication devices are banned at the examination premises. Any infringement of these instructions shall entail disciplinary action including disqualification.
- 10. Candidates found in possession of mobile phones, smart/digital/wrist watches, Bluetooth devices, cameras, pen drives and other electronic gadgets inside the Examination Hall will be deemed to have been using unfair means and would be liable to be disqualified.
- 11. Candidates will be allowed to appear for the examination only in the venue specified in their e-Admission certificate.

- 12. The candidates are directed not to write or sign anywhere in the e-Admission certificate before the examination.
- 13. The candidates must put his/her signature in the e-Admission certificate in the presence of the Invigilator only, in each of the eight sessions of the examination, in the respective space provided/indicated in the e-Admission certificate.
- 14. Candidates are allowed to use simple analog wrist watch for the Combined Competitive (Mains) Examination, 2020.
- 15. Each candidate will be issued only one QCA- no replacement QCA booklet will be furnished under any circumstances. Also no additional pages/sheets will be furnished. Candidates must write in the specified space provided in the Question cum Answer (QCA) Booklets.
- 16. The candidates should be careful while taking away the detachable question paper, and must ensure that all the pages of the QCA are intact, at the time of submission to the invigilator at the end of the examination.
- 17. Use of Scientific (Non-Programmable type) Calculators is allowed for **Engineering subjects and Mathematics (Paper II) only**. Programmable type calculators are, however, not allowed.
- 18. Candidates should write answers only with black/blue ball point pen. Writing with gel pen/ink pen/pencil is not allowed. However, dark pencils may be used for drawing diagrams, sketches etc.
- 19. Candidates will be required to bring Covid 19 double vaccination certificate. They will be subjected to thermal screening at the entry of the venue.
- 20. In case the a candidate's body temperature reads above normal, he/she will be subjected to RAT by the Medical Team present at the venue.
- 21. Violation of any instruction(s) shall entail cancellation of candidature of the candidate in addition to any other appropriate action that may be taken by the Commission.
- 22. Candidates are advised to access the APSC website regularly for latest updates/instructions relating to the Combined Competitive (Mains) Examination, 2020.
